Looking for something specific? We also offer **contract growing** for other species to suit your unique needs.

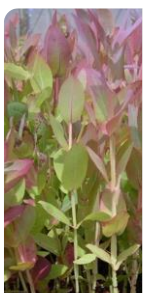
Here are just a few of the popular species currently available:



**Eucalyptus globulus
(Tasmanian Blue Gum)**
Fast-growing and frost-hardy once established. Thrives in sunny, moist, well-drained sites. Native to SE Tasmania, east coast, and Bass Strait islands.
Height: Up to 90m



**Acacia Melanoxydon
(Tasmanian Blackwood)**
Hardy Moderate-Sized Tree
Tolerates diverse sites; thrives in cool climates with moist, well-drained soil. Great for shelter, shade, or as a feature tree.
Height: 5–25m



**Eucalyptus nitens
(Shining Gum)**
Fast-growing tall plantation tree for cool, high-altitude climates; cold-tolerant.
Height: 30–50m



**Pinus radiata
(Radiata Pine)**
Moderate-sized, conical tree ideal for plantations and shelterbelts. Originally from California, it thrives in varied conditions but prefers well-drained soil.
Height: 15–30m+
